The cold is still here, but the light is stretching further. The days are getting longer, even if it's hard to notice at first. Change is happening, slow and steady. This is how most things happen—not in big, dramatic moments, but in small shifts that add up over time. And if you're not paying attention, you miss them.

The Feast of the Presentation—Mary and Joseph bring Jesus to the temple. It's an ordinary act, something countless parents had done before them. Nothing about it looks special. But waiting there are Simeon and Anna, two people who have spent their whole lives watching. The moment they see Jesus, they know. "My eyes have seen your salvation." No doubts. No hesitation. They don't need a sign. They've been preparing for this their whole lives.

That's the kind of awareness I want. The ability to see what matters, to recognize what's real, to not miss the important moments because I was too distracted by everything else. It's easy to let days slip by in routine, to go through the motions and not really be present.

Lent is around the corner. While we aren't there yet, we do have a new way to step into that awareness. Our new Stations of the Cross at the Catholic Center begin at the tabernacle and move clockwise around the church. It's a path of focus, a way to physically move with Christ, to see and feel His presence in a tangible way. Use it. Walk it. Let it be a reminder that faith isn't about waiting for something to happen—it's about stepping into what is already unfolding

The light of Christ is always with us!
