Dear Catholic Center Community,

Happy 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time! On Saturday, we had our 47th Annual 5K Human Race. Someone just the other day shared with me that he loves our race name. I think I shared this before that it only dawned on me recently after years of organizing the race – that the race is called "Human Race". I can't help but ponder on the reasons why 47 years ago the Catholic Center chose this name.

Perhaps, the original inspiration for the name of the race had to do with the beautiful teachings of our faith. The Catholic Church teaches that the human race is created in the image of God, and that all humans have inherent dignity. Because of our common origin in God the human race forms a unity, without excluding the rich variety of persons, cultures and peoples. This assures us that we are all brothers and sisters of the one Father.

Even though we began this new year 2025 with a number of tragedies and natural disasters, we also witnessed the beauty of humanity shining forth, caring for one another. We see people volunteering to cook and shelter strangers after hurricanes and wildfires. We hear people speaking on behalf of those who are voiceless. We are moved by people's generosity and courageous actions in helping one another.

This fundamental belief propels the Catholic Church to speak on issues of life and shed light on the beauty and mystery of our shared humanity. Just last week, Archbishop Hartmayer and all the bishops in Georgia released a joint statement: "As spiritual leaders, we recognize the diversity of the flock entrusted to us and are concerned about the welfare of those who have immigrated to Georgia seeking a better life for themselves and their families through honest work... The immigrants we meet every day in our ministry are faithful people who are dedicated to God, the Church, family, and community." In issuing this statement, our bishops hope to put a human face to the immigration crisis.

I think the hope of those who named our 5K the "Human Race" is to celebrate our shared dignity and goodness since we share in the same sanctity of human life. God is love and full of goodness; this is the image and likeness of God that we are called to be. This year we chose this quote from St. Augustine for our t-shirt to focus our run and our journey through life.

"Love is itself the fulfillment of all our works. There is the goal; that is why we run: we run toward it, and once we reach it, in it we shall find rest."
