Here is the principle I've been reflecting on - Lent is about love first and foremost. Learning how to love—and how to be loved.

That is the heart of it. Every liturgical season of our life is shaped by this, just through different lenses. Our call is always the same: to move toward God as disciples. The path we walk is our vocation. The setting is our vineyard—where God chooses to work through us.

Real love takes honesty, humility, courage, and trust. We practice that in Lent through fasting, prayer, almsgiving, service—acts that stretch us.

Lent is almost a re-training in love - an annual return to what matters most!

To forgive again.

To pray even when it's dry. To serve when it's hard.

To stay faithful, even when it costs something.

Also, this community is strong! Thank you as always to all of our volunteers who continue to volunteer. Thank you for welcoming the Capuchin Franciscans (Fr Lijo) in my absence.

On another note, thank you for your patience the past few weekends. I've been traveling—Peru, Nashville Cathedral for a wedding, and the North Georgia mountains with 150 of our students on retreat. It was full, beautiful, and powerful. Many of our students encountered God in real ways. I'm going to the Gulf of Florida with my family in April. Looking forward to some family time.

As we look ahead to Holy Week, I invite you to ask: How is God calling me to grow in love—for Him, for others, and for myself?

These are not abstract questions. They are the questions of the Christian life.

Let us pray for each other!

Let us finish this season well.
