Dear Catholic Center Community,

Happy Palm Sunday! This week we begin Holy Week. It is a time for us to deeply reflect on the events of Jesus' final week, including his teachings, suffering, and death. It often evokes feelings of sadness, grief, and sorrow for the suffering of Jesus and the consequences of sin. Despite the somber nature of Holy Week, there is also a sense of hope and anticipation for the resurrection of Jesus, which marks the beginning of a new life and salvation for all of us believers.

I feel like I have been living this Lent as a long Holy Week with feelings of sadness, hope and joy; all held in tension. I think by now most of you have heard the announcement in the bulletin of the closure of Oasis and the departure of us Handmaid sisters (Sr. Margarita and myself) from Athens in June. This was one of the most difficult decisions made by us as a Province, but we need to consolidate our ministries (like the Franciscans). What makes this decision especially hard for me is because of the many relationships and friendships that have been formed here at the Catholic Center and at Oasis in the past 7 years. It is hard because of the privilege of walking with our brothers and sisters at Oasis when they feel vulnerable and when they are most in need. For the past 23 years of serving at Oasis, we sisters have witnessed how God has been at work in the hearts of so many people. Your generous donations have made an impact, especially in the lives of those who struggle to meet their basic needs. Our tutors, from UGA and the Catholic Center, have given hope to so many families as they help our young students learn and grow to their full potential. It has been a joy for us sisters to be part of these encounters and friendships. For all of these, my heart is full of gratitude even though I am also mourning as I say my farewell.

As we begin Holy Week, let us remember that in Christ Jesus we have the grace to hold sadness, hope and joy all together. Life has its joys and sorrows, but beyond the darkness we glimpse a light in the cross and resurrection of Christ. Christ's resurrection contains a vital power which has permeated this world. The cross and resurrection of Christ show us that God is mysteriously capable of intervening, that God does not abandon us and can bring good out of any situation by his power and infinite creativity. Therefore, as we say good-bye, we trust that our relationships are held in Christ and that we are always united in the Eucharist, the sacrament of love and unity.

Let us keep each other in prayers as we bid farewell!
