Easter feels especially real to me this year. Not because everything is perfect – not even close! But because I am seeing more clearly how God meets us in the places we least expect.

I have been sitting with the story of Mary Magdalene. She was the first person to encounter the Risen Christ. She did not show up to the tomb with confidence or clarity... she came in grief. She just wanted to be close to Jesus, even in His death. And somehow, in that place of loss, Jesus meets her. Not with answers, just her name.

Whether you feel close to God or not at all, I want to say this: He has not forgotten you. He is not done with your story.

The same Jesus who walked out of the grave is still calling people by name, still showing up in unexpected ways, still bringing life out of things that felt dead. I see this in my ministry here at the Catholic Center, in lives of students and permanent members alike. Easter is not just a great holiday, but also a deep reminder that resurrection is real! And it is for you, for me, for all of us.
