## A Message from Fr. Michael

*I know them...* 

*No one can take them out of My hand...* and no one can take them out of the Father's hand. - John 10

Athens has two modes of existence: school mode and summer mode. And they couldn't be more different: traffic and lines for restaurants are in the extremes between each mode, the overall feel of the town different between each. The locals also live in a dichotomy, hibernating during the school year and blossoming in the summer. Even the students who are around notice how different they feel whether they are in school or in summer mode.

There's an invitation here to be aware of the different pockets and compartments of my life, and how they affect me: some of the modes of my life are peaceful and tranquil, the other compartments put me in the mode of fight/flight/freeze/fawn. Students can feel the pressure of the school year but when summer comes around it can be a bit of an identity crisis, not knowing who they are because of not knowing what to do with themselves without the haste of school. The switch between modes can be oscillating and difficult to transition between one or the other.

In light of that awareness that any of us might feel, going between different modes in our life, how God might be a possible remedy in each mode of existence: the God who knows death and life, the two essential modes of existence. The Resurrection, which we celebrate - not simply in Easter, but year round, especially on Sundays (the first day of the week) - is God's answer to the oscillation of life.

God exists as only one mode of existence: a Love without limit, literally un-conditional. Especially seen in the Paschal mystery, whether in life or in death, God is there. It is a generous Love without limit that found humanity in the tomb, and it is the gratuitous Love that takes us to heaven, where we cannot get to alone. There will be many oscillating seasons and modes of our life, but only one consistency through each: God.


## **Silver Angels Meet May 13**
