At the Easter Vigil Mass and at the Confirmation Mass with Bishop Konzen on Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church lovingly welcomed 7 new members through Baptism and full initiation, 19 previously baptized members through reception into full communion and full initiation into the Catholic Church from other Christian traditions, and fully initiated 21 baptized Catholic members through Confirmation (5 of whom received the Eucharist for the first time).

To our newest Catholics and those recently confirmed, I hope that you have been able to reflect on the mystery of our salvation through Jesus’ death and resurrection, especially in the celebration of the Mass in this Easter season. I pray that as the Easter season comes to a close in a few short weeks with the solemnity of Pentecost (June 8), we will all be renewed in our mission to proclaim Christ to the world in word and deed.

I would like to ask the whole community: Did you know that you play a vital role in our community’s OCIA (Christian Initiation) ministry? Before a person approaches a priest or initiation ministry coordinator, that person has been evangelized by someone. God works through all of you to draw people to want to know Him more! This is what we call the “inquiry” period in OCIA. All Catholics are ministers of the inquiry period and are called to proclaim the gospel to those seeking truth. If you know of someone interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, we have inquiry nights once a month throughout the summer (first one is May 22nd at 7 pm in the Center Hall) before we start meeting in September for spiritual formation sessions. If you are interested in being involved in OCIA ministry as a sponsor or volunteer in some capacity, or have any questions about becoming Catholic you can contact Suzie Blaydes at sacraments@ccatuga.org.

Our new pope, Leo XIV, spent over a decade of his priesthood in missionary work, and we can take his example as inspiration to be missionaries in our own community- to be missionaries of hope in this time God has created us for!
