Thank you Catholic Center! With your great support, we packed **186,624 meals** last weekend for children in desperate need! Over 100 volunteers from the Catholic Center helped pack and many donors helped us exceed our fundraising goal (current donations: **\$68,610 vs. goal of \$65,000**). This was the maximum amount we can pack with one tractor/trailer load so next year we'll be going to two tractor/trailer loads and will pack 250,000 meals. Any additional donations will give us a head-start for next year.
