

Catholic Center at UGA Parking Permit Rules & Restrictions

Registered active members of the UGA Catholic Center (students and faculty) are eligible to purchase a parking permit at the Catholic Center for the 2025-2026 school year. Permits will be valid for the fall and spring semesters from August 13, 2025, through May 5, 2026.

Parking at the Catholic Center is NOT permitted during classes without a valid permit and hang tag.

Permits issued through this program are not for athletic events or other UGA campus activities. UGA Football Parking is a separate program.

When UGA is in session, permit parking is allowed between the hours of **7:00AM and 6:00PM** Monday through Friday, except when permit lots are needed to accommodate Center events (e.g. large funerals.)

If lots are unavailable, we will make every effort to notify permit holders by text and email at least 24 hours in advance of the event/closure. No parking is permitted in the Catholic Center lots after **5:00 PM on the Friday nights before a home UGA football game**. **Permit parking is not available on weekends or holidays and overnight parking is not permitted.**

It is permissible for the permit holder to use the hang when using a vehicle other than his/her primary registered vehicle with notification to the office. However, the Catholic Center's parking program is intended to be a benefit and convenience for our UGA student and faculty members. The intent of the program should be respected and treated as such.

There are no assigned parking spaces but hang tags should be **visibly displayed** (hanging from the rear-view mirror.) **Permit holders may only park behind the center**. Parking around the Chapel is reserved for those who are praying or visiting the front office. Permit holders may be towed if parked around the Chapel and not in the designated permit parking. (Non-permit holders will be towed if parked in permit parking during parking permit hours.)

Permits will be assigned directly by the Catholic Center.

Transfer or resale of parking permits is strictly forbidden.

If a permit holder no longer has use for his/her space, the space should be released back to the Catholic Center office for reassignment.

Any violation or abuse of the above policies and restrictions may result in towing (at the permit holder's expense) and revocation of permit. No refunds will be issued.

Parking permit holder hereby agrees on behalf of himself/herself, their heirs, executors, administrators, agents, family members, officers, volunteers, helpers, partners, organizational members or associates to waive, release, defend, protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the UGA Catholic Center against any and all claims that arise out of parking permit holder's use of facilities and/or parking lots at the UGA Catholic Center.
