**A Message from Fr. Michael**

*Jesus said to His disciples, “I have so much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now” - John 16*

Relationship changes everything. If I have a broken leg and no doctor in my life, then the situation is shaped by that fact and there is no hope. On the other hand, if I have a broken leg and I have a relationship with a doctor, then that relationship changes the situation completely.

In fact, the various core identities I have come from the relationships I’m in. For example, the only reason I have the identity of ‘child’ is because I have a relationship with two parents; the only reason I have the identity of ‘sibling’ is because I have a relationship with a sibling; the only reason a person can have the identity of ‘parent’ is if they have a relationship with a child. Relationship changes everything: I would not exist if two people did not have a relationship with each other. And perhaps the most paradoxical of all the identities I have is ‘stranger’ because I have a relationship with people I do not yet know.

We celebrate Trinity Sunday, where we are reminded of the center of everything: relationship. God the Father would not be the Father if there was not a relationship with God the Son, and they would not be in continuous unceasing unity if it were not for their relationship with God the Holy Spirit; each receiving their identity based on their relationship to the other. It is a reminder that we are in relationship with the God who is Relationship, and this God has given every single one of our relationships to us.

The invitation is to place primacy on the relationships we have. One way this becomes clear is when two people go on a date and are asked about it afterwards: “how was it?” When one of the people describes the date, there is still more a person wants to know: ultimately, “how was the connection?” The experience described can sometimes be superficial, but the connection between two people, the relationship is what is key: have a terrible date but a strong connection, or a great date but weak connection; relationship makes all the difference.

One of the ways this begins to help us in the spiritual life: prayer. We might be able to say that prayer was great but unless the connection between us and God becomes substantial, a “great prayer” might not matter too much. On the flip side, to have terrible prayer might end up being helpful to us because we can say something like this to God, “well, I did not have the prayer I want, but at least, God, I have You.”
