

Catholic Center at UGA: Parking Rules & Regulations

Parking at the Catholic Center is extremely limited. Permits are a privilege reserved for registered, active members (students and faculty) and are issued via a random lottery for the academic year (August 17, 2026 – May 7, 2027).

Core Permit Guidelines

- **Hours:** Valid Monday–Friday, 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM, only when UGA is in session.
- **Location:** Permit holders must park **behind the Center only**. Parking in front of the office or around the Chapel is strictly prohibited and **will result in towing at the owner's expense**.
- **Display:** Hang tags must be clearly visible from the rearview mirror at all times. **Three citations** for failure to display a permit will result in the immediate loss of the permit without a refund.
- **Restrictions:** No overnight, weekend, or holiday parking. Permits are **not valid** for UGA football games or other campus events.

Special Events & Closures

- **Lot Closures:** The Catholic Center reserves the right to close the lot for funerals or special events. Staff will attempt to notify permit holders via GroupMe and email in advance. **It is the permit holder's responsibility to monitor these channels.**
- **Football Weekends:** The lot must be vacated by **5:00 PM on the Friday before a home UGA football game**. Vehicles remaining after this time will be towed.

Policies & Enforcement

- **Non-Transferable:** Resale or transfer of permits is strictly forbidden. If you no longer need your permit, please return it to the office for reassignment.
 - **Vehicle Changes:** You may use your tag in a secondary vehicle only if you provide **prior written notification** (make, model, and plate) to the Center office.
 - **Violations:** Abuse of these policies—including parking in unauthorized areas—will result in **towing, permit revocation, and no refund**.
 - **Liability:** By accepting a permit, the holder agrees to waive all claims and hold the UGA Catholic Center harmless for any damages, theft, or issues arising from the use of the parking facilities.
